DUKE expects all students who are not in their first semester to be registered for "Continuation" credit. This appears as one semester-course credit unit at Duke but *does not transfer* onto a UNC Transcript.

*DUKE graduate courses are counted in semester hours and will count as the same credit hours at UNC.*

*Duke undergraduate courses are counted in "semester-course credit units".*
