In that case, Valerie will change your thesis credit course from GERM 994 to GERM 992. You will also need to apply to graduate on both campuses

Dissertating Students: You should enroll in three credit hours of GERM 994 at UNC, and ALSO (if not studying abroad) enroll in the Grad Colloquium, GERMAN 995 (1 semester hour) at Duke, for every semester when you are dissertating.

Important Information!

UNC requires full-time enrollment for all students. This consists of EITHER a minimum of 9 credit hours, OR 3 credit hours of GERM 994: Thesis/Dissertation Credit (plus any other courses).

DUKE expects all students who are not in their first semester to be registered for "Continuation" credit. This appears as one semester-course credit unit at Duke but does not transfer onto a UNC Transcript.

DUKE graduate courses are counted in semester hours and will count as the same credit hours at UNC.

Duke undergraduate courses are counted in "semester-course credit units". IF Duke undergraduate courses are taken, the one semester-course credit unit at Duke will count as three credit hours at UNC.
